Guidelines for Submitting Entries to **Focus on Brook Farm V**

Deadline for all submissions: January 31, 2020.

All works must have a connection to the Brook Farm site and its history.

PHOTOS:

- All images must be taken at the Brook Farm Historic Site.
- Each photographer may submit up to three images.
- Images should be uncompressed JPG files at the final image size (8"x10") at 300 dpi. That ends up being about 3.5-4 megabytes as a file size.
- Rename each photo as follows: Last name_First name_1 (or 2 or 3)
- Send each photo attached in a separate e-mail to: info@newbrookfarm.org, Subject line: "PHOTO [number of photo], [Your name]"
- In the body of your message, please describe where on the Brook Farm site the photo was taken. Also state your age group: Age 6-12, Age 13-18, Over age 18.

PROSE AND POETRY:

- Send a Word document or PDF to: info@newbrookfarm.org. Please include your full name and age category: Age 6-12, Age 13-18, Over age 18.

VISUAL ARTS AND CRAFTS:
